Draft Resolution November 16, 2021



Whereas, Classes are cancelled during Thanksgiving and the Friday after Thanksgiving and,

Whereas, The Thanksgiving holiday is one of the busiest travel days of the year; and,

Whereas, Students may take advantage of travelling back home during the Thanksgiving holiday the Wednesday prior to Thanksgiving, and,

Whereas, Classes are not cancelled the Wednesday prior to the Thanksgiving holiday which may cause difficulty for students to travel back home; and,

Whereas, Instruction should still continue on Wednesday as it is designated as an instruction day on the Academic Calendar; therefore be it,

Resolved, That Faculty Senate endorse the recommendations to accommodate undergraduate students for the Wednesday prior to Thanksgiving:

- Survey undergraduate student plans for the Thanksgiving holiday;
- Continue normal instruction and excusing undergraduate student absences to have no effect on their grade the Wednesday prior to the Thanksgiving holiday;
- Change the modality of instruction to a synchronous virtual format on the Wednesday prior to the Thanksgiving holiday; and/or,
- Change the modality of instruction to an asynchronous virtual format on the Wednesday prior to the Thanksgiving holiday.

Resolved, That these recommendations are to be determined by individual faculty members and are not a mandate or change in University policy.
