

Advisory committee resumes search work

The presidential search and selection advisory committee in two meetings this past weekend reviewed with John Bruff, chairman of the Board of Trustees and committee member, the activities of the trustees in regard to nominees for president.

A press release from committee chairman, Robert Barker, chairman of biochemistry, says, that Bruff called the nominees from the committee "excellent individuals" and thanked committee members for their work.

Barker says that Bruff reported the "board's pledge to proceed in all future matters under the guidelines adopted at the beginning of the search and selection process."

"While the board continues to have the committee's nominees under consider-

ation," Barker says, "it is the board's intention to exercise the option of making additional nominations to the committee."

Barker says the committee agreed to review and interview additional nominees. "We will be treating the nominees from the board the same, or as closely as possible, to the earlier nominees," Barker says.

The committee will gather information, ballot, interview and make recommendations, Barker says.

"The All-University Search and Selection Advisory Committee and the Board of Trustees are mutually pledged to recruit and select the best possible President for Michigan State University," he says.
