## Faculty Council to elect search committee member

The Steering Committee met Monday to set the agenda for the next Academic Council meeting and to plan for a special meeting of the Faculty Council to elect a faculty member to the All-University Presidential Search and Selection Advisory Committee.

Academic Council will meet at 3:15 p.m. May 29 in the Con Con Room of the International Center. That meeting will be recessed at an appropriate time to enable the Faculty Council to conduct the election to replace advisory committee member Robert Barker, professor of biochemistry, who will be leaving the University about July 1.

On the slate, prepared by the faculty members of the University Committee on Academic Governance, are Frank W. Cambray, professor of geology, and Paul T. Magee, professor of microbiology and public health.

The Academic Council will face a lengthy agenda which includes:

+A regular report from the University Committee on Curriculum;

+The standard request from UCC for authorization to act on behalf of the council on curriculum matters during the summer, subject to council review in the fall:

+A report on I-incomplete policy from the University Committee on Academic Policy (for details, see *News-Bulletin*, May 17, 1979);

+A report from the provost's office regarding "On Campus Registration— Lifelong Education" and a related application form for on-campus registration of "unclassified" students;

+Proposed Bylaws of the Athletic Council which were passed by Faculty Council on May 8; and

+Proposed amendment to section 5.2.2 of the *Bylaws for Academic Governance* regarding the selection of faculty members on the Athletic Council.

This amendment, proposed by the UCAG at the recommendation of Frederick Horne, professor of chemistry, was up before Academic Council on April 3, but council voted to delay consideration until the athletic bylaws came forward for consideration as well.

The Steering Committee, including newly-elected members, will meet at 2:45 p.m. May 29 in the Con Con Room to elect officers for 1979-80.
