Transfer student policies and initiatives:

We reset the culture each year and typically this is what a chairperson would do.

Thinking like a representative of your academic unit and as a representative of the university please think about the following. Only 18% of transfers successfully do it so there is an increasing stress to better that rate. We are in the 10 ten transfer Universities. Has something to do with our ethos as a University- I have never seen transfer students seen as outsiders. We could increase the number of students that graduate as transfer students at a 1/3 of cost of just coming to MSU. Our funding is now based upon the Provost & Vice Provost signing a contract to better its transfer activities.

The 2 kinds of students we have are traditionally 82% & transfer students at 87%. We have the Michigan transfer agreement where if they meet the general requirements of their community college to obtain an associate degree.

Reform/revision of drops/withdraw policies

There are federal laws that must be met when they disenroll which could impact their ability to retake, etc. We may need to push or ask questions about.
