Proposed Amendment to the Bylaws for Academic Governance

Approved by the University Committee on Academic Governance on January 19, 2023

<u>1.1.2.1.</u> The voting faculty in the election of University-level councils and committees shall be all regular faculty, health professions faculty, and FRIB/NSCL faculty. Voting faculty also includes full-time fixed-term faculty who have served at least three consecutive years and full-time academic specialists who have served at least three consecutive years. Voting faculty must be engaged in academic activities of the university.

<u>1.1.2.5.</u> A full-time fixed-term faculty member who has served at least three consecutiveyears and a full-time specialist who has served at least three consecutive years may be elected to an academic governance body, with the exception of the University Committee on Faculty Tenure, as a representative of any unit in which the person holds faculty status.
