Financial Aid in 2010-11

69%, or 35,700 students, received some type of aid (loans, grants, scholarships, work-study).

59%, or 30,600 students, received federal aid via the FAFSA.

Approximately 25% of all undergraduates were Pell-eligible, over 9,600 recipients.

Total of all aid disbursed was \$602,275,109, almost a 3% increase from the prior year.
